Pictures: Residents are permitted to hang their own pictures or request assistance from our Maintenance staff. Maintenance services are available Monday through Friday and such requests can be made through the front desk. As this service is considered a courtesy service, please be aware that The Plaza will not be responsible for any damages to your personal belongings.

Blinds/Curtains: White blinds are provided with your apartment. Residents are permitted to hang decorative curtains, but we ask that the blinds remain on the windows.

Linens: The Plaza will provide towels, which will be laundered once per week on your assigned housekeeping day. Residents may provide their own decorative towels and The Plaza will launder such towels upon request. The Plaza will also provide white twin sized sheets and a twin-sized blanket. Residents using a bed any other size than a twin will need to provide two sets of their own sheets. The Plaza will launder such sheets once per week.

Bathmats: The Plaza will provide a bathmat which will be laundered once per week. Residents are permitted to provide their own bathmats, but we recommend they have a non-slip material underneath. Rugs in the apartments are not recommended as they are a trip hazard.

Shower Curtain: The Plaza provides a standard white shower curtain. Residents in private apartments are permitted to add another decorative curtain of their choice if they desire.
