

Coronavirus (COVID-19) Resident & Family Update No Visitations & Tours Extended

Effective September 2, 2020

The Plaza Assisted Living has always adhered to recommended health and safety standards to protect our Residents, their Families, our Team Members and Vendor Partners. Our six communities have been well prepared and trained in infection control as part of our standard operating procedures since the start of the COVID-19 pandemic.

Due to the significant increase in daily COVID-19 counts and in alignment with Mayor Kirk Caldwell's latest Emergency Order 2020-25 (Stay at Home, Work from Home), we will be extending the stop of non-essential visits (including family, friends, tours) to all six of our communities until further notice. This restriction does not include those visiting for an end of life circumstance.

As the State works toward navigating the COVID-19 pandemic, The Plaza will continue to follow the guidance of the Hawaii State Department of Health and other government and healthcare experts.
