



Coronavirus (COVID-19) Update:
The Plaza at Kaneohe – COVID-19 Free
Latest Round of Testing 100% Negative

August 9, 2021

Since learning of our first confirmed COVID-19 positive Team Member on July 24, 2021, The Plaza at Kaneohe has operated in an abundance of caution and conducted weekly testing for all of its Hali'a Memory Care Residents and close contact Team Members. Per the recommendation of the Hawaii State Department of Health, three rounds of SARS-CoV-2 viral/antigen testing were executed within a 14-day window to ensure no spread of the virus had occurred. On Saturday, August 7, we received results from our latest round of testing and learned that all Hali'a Memory Care Residents and close contact Team Members were confirmed negative for the coronavirus. After three rounds of 100% negative test results, The Plaza at Kaneohe is now considered a COVID-19 free facility.

We thank you for your understanding and support as we took the necessary steps toward getting The Plaza at Kaneohe COVID-19 free. Additionally, we ask for your continued patience as we adjust visitations and other guidelines as a response to the recent spikes in COVID-19 cases within our State.

As reminder, effective Saturday, August 7, 2021, all indoor visitations have been halted. Outdoor, window and virtual visits are available by appointment. While Residents may leave the community as needed, we highly recommended and request that they only leave for essential appointments. Residents should maintain mask usage if leaving the community including when traveling in vehicles. If a Resident decides to leave the community, they will be subject to clearance of the Entrance Screening upon return.
