



Coronavirus (COVID-19) Update:
The Plaza at Punchbowl – Free of COVID-19
Latest Round of Testing 100% Negative

August 9, 2021

Since learning that one of our Residents had tested positive for COVID-19 on July 22, 2021, The Plaza at Punchbowl has followed the guidance of the Hawaii State Department of Health regarding testing, quarantining and isolating. Per their recommendation, three rounds of testing were executed within a 14-day window to ensure no spread of the virus had occurred within the community. Today, we are happy to report that all results from our latest round of testing of all Team Members and close contact Residents, were confirmed negative for the coronavirus. After three rounds of 100% negative test results, The Plaza at Punchbowl is now considered a COVID-19 free facility.

We thank you for your understanding and support as we took the necessary steps toward getting The Plaza at Punchbowl cleared. Additionally, we ask for your continued patience as we adjust visitations and other guidelines as a response to the recent spikes in COVID-19 cases within our State.

As reminder, effective Saturday, August 7, 2021, all indoor visitations have been halted. Outdoor, window and virtual visits are available by appointment. While Residents may leave the community as needed, we highly recommended and request that they only leave for essential appointments. Residents should maintain mask usage if leaving the community, including when traveling in vehicles. If a Resident decides to leave the community, they will be subject to clearance of the Entrance Screening upon return.
