



Coronavirus (COVID-19) Update:

The Plaza at Kane'ohē – Confirmed COVID-19 of Team Member

As COVID-19 cases continue to rise, The Plaza Assisted Living remains vigilant in its fight to keep the virus out of our communities. We follow all recommended health and safety standards to protect our Residents, their Families, our Team Members and Vendor Partners. Our six communities have been well prepared and have received continual training on infection control throughout the pandemic.

Unfortunately, today we received confirmation that a Team Member at The Plaza at Kaneohe, tested positive for COVID-19. The individual's last day of work was Monday, August 23, 2021 and is considered a direct care Team Member whose assignment was restricted to the Lamaku Extended Care floor. This individual is only employed at The Plaza at Kaneohe and not shared with other sister Plaza communities. As a result, all who may have come into close contact are being reached out to by the Administrator, Dorothy Abreu. We will begin performing an antigen test on these individuals today.

As we await further guidance from the Hawaii State Department of Health, and for the safety of our Residents, all residing on the Lamaku Extended Care floor are currently being quarantined. As soon as we receive formal direction from DOH, we will provide another update. All communal activities and dining for Lamaku Extended Care Residents will be halted and meals delivered to their apartments, until further notice.
