



Coronavirus (COVID-19) Update:

The Plaza at Pearl City – 100% of Tests Confirmed Negative

August 24, 2021

On Thursday, August 19, 2021 a notification was sent out reporting that a Team Member, who's assignment was primarily on the Assisted Living floor, had tested positive for COVID-19. As a result, all Residents and Team Members who may have come into close contact with this individual received a COVID-19 PCR test and all other non-close contact Assisted Living Team Members received a COVID-19 viral/antigen test; all tests were reported as negative.

A second round of testing was conducted on Sunday, August 22 for all close contact Residents and all Team Members who work on the Assisted Living floor. Today we are happy to share that 100% of those results were confirmed negative.

Per the direction of the Hawaii State Department of Health, all Assisted Living Residents will continue to remain on quarantine until one more round of testing occurs and is confirmed 100% negative for the coronavirus. Arrangements have been made to conduct this testing on August 29 for all close contact Residents and all Team Members who work on the Assisted Living floor.

Communal activities and dining for Assisted Living Residents will be halted and meals delivered to their apartments, until further notice. Additionally, visitations will not be allowed for Assisted Living Residents until we have received the all clear.

We thank you for your patience and understanding as we continue to work toward getting The Plaza at Pearl City COVID-19 free.
