



## **Coronavirus (COVID-19) Update:**

### **The Plaza at Mililani**

#### **Non-Direct Care Team Member Positive for COVID-19**

September 3, 2021

As COVID-19 cases continue to rise, The Plaza Assisted Living remains vigilant in its fight to keep the virus out of our communities. We follow all recommended health and safety standards to protect our Residents, their Families, our Team Members and Vendor Partners. Our six communities have been well prepared and have received continual training on infection control throughout the pandemic.

Unfortunately yesterday, we received confirmation that a Team Member at The Plaza at Mililani, tested positive for COVID-19. The individual's last day of work was Tuesday, August 31, 2021, and is considered a non-direct care Team Member. This individual is only employed at The Plaza at Mililani and not shared with other sister Plaza communities. As a result, all who may have come into close contact have been informed and administered COVID-19 antigen tests; 100% of which came back as negative.

Since all initial tests were confirmed negative, the Hawaii State Department of Health has advised that an additional round of COVID-19 antigen tests be administered for all close contacts within 5-7 days. If 100% of these tests are confirmed negative as well, The Plaza at Mililani will be given the all clear.

No Resident services (i.e. dining, activities, nursing) will be impacted and will continue as normal.
