## Testing Results 100% Negative, Community Cleared of COVID-19

September 8, 2021

On Tuesday, August 24, 2021 an update was sent reporting that a Team Member who's assignment was restricted to the Lamaku Extended Care program had tested positive for COVID-19. Per the direction of the Hawaii State Department of Health, three rounds COVID-19 antigen testing were conducted for all close contact Residents and all Team Members who work on the Lamaku Extended Care floor. Today we are happy to share that 100% of the results, from the latest round that occurred on Monday, September 6, was confirmed negative.

**Effective immediately, all Residents on the Lamaku Extended Care floor will be released from quarantine.**

Communal activities and dining for Lamaku Residents will resume on **Thursday, September 9**. Additionally, outdoor visitations by appointment will again be allowed for Lamaku Extended Care Residents.
